# Requirements for registration of organic and inconversion plant reproductive material in the Swedish database

To meet the requirement that the plant reproductive material must be available on the territory of Sweden (according to Article 26.1 and 2a in (EU) 2018/848) we have the following requirements:

### **Last Date for Registration**

The supplier has to register plant propagation material no later than:

- 1. 20 October of the year before the spring season for agricultural spring varieties and horticultural varieties
- 2. 1 June in the case of winter oil seed varieties, and
- 3. 20 July in the case of other agricultural winter varieties.

#### **Available for Order**

Registered material shall be available for order no later than:

- 1. 1<sup>st</sup> of December in the case for agricultural spring varieties and species intended for horticulture;
- 2. 10<sup>th</sup> of June in the case of winter oil seed varieties, and
- 3. 10<sup>th</sup> of August in the case of other agricultural winter varieties.

# **Quantity in Weight of the Seed**

To register plant reproductive material, the quantity in weight of the seed of the following crops also hast to be at least

- 1. 500 kg for Winter Oil Seed,
- 2. 3 tonnes for Potatoes,
- 3. 5 tonnes for Blue Lupin -Lupinus angustifolius
- 4. 25 tonnes for Cereals and Pulses,
- 5. 3 tonnes for Fodder Maize,
- 6. 1 ton of Grass Seed for Fodder purposes of
  - a) English ryegrass Lolium perenne,
  - b) Cocksfoot, Orchardgrass Dactylis glomerata,
  - c) Italian ryegrass Lolium multiflorum,
  - d) Alfalfa Medicago sativa L,
  - e) Festulolium Festulolium (Festuca ssp. x Lolium ssp.),
  - f) Red Clover Trifolium pratense,

- g) Red Fescue Festuca rubra,
- h) Tall Fescue Festuca arundinacea,
- i) Timothy Phleum pratense,
- j) White Clover Trifolium repens,
- k) Westerwolds Ryegrass *Lolium multiflorum var.* westerwoldicum,
- Kentucky Bluegrass, Smooth Meadowgrass, June Grass, Spear Grass - Poa pratensis,
- m) Meadow Fescue Festuca pratensis, and
- 7. 200 kilos of other species of grass seed intended for fodder purposes.

## **Deregistration**

The supplier has to deregister the plant propagation material when the suppliers available quantity is less than the quantities specified above. Registered plant propagating material of cereals and pulses must, however, only be deregistered when the quantity is less than 15 tonnes.
